

Reassemble the sticks. The joke on each stick has a time of day as a punchline. Scanning the coupon will reveal the hands of the clocks are popsicle sticks. Each joke can similarly be formed into the hands of a clock. Use the provided binder clips to hold the pieces in the correct positions will make it easier to manipulate them. When correctly assembled, the ICEBERG logo will be right-side up. This can be used to help figure out the more difficult jokes/jokes.

After assembling them, notice that there are two sticks for each color. Once like-colored sticks are combined so their ICEBERG logos overlapping, they will form letters and numbers: 420AM. Type this into ClueKeeper, and it will tell you to spell out the final answer: **FOURTWENTYAM**, the Time of Death
